



For Non-Union Workers:



1. Timely Forms Matter:
Complete all required forms on time and set up your online access early to stay on top of your benefits.



2. One Point of Contact:
Always send updates or inquiries to Cathy Jones, not directly to Manulife. This helps streamline communication and prevents delays.



3. Communicate Life Changes Promptly:
Major life events—like welcoming a child, celebrating a 12-month cohabitation milestone, or experiencing the dissolution of a relationship—can impact your benefits. Be sure to inform Cathy Jones within 60 days to keep everything up to date. This small step ensures a seamless process.

Making the Most of Your Resources

Payroll Processes and Year-End Planning:

As payroll timelines remain steady, now is the perfect time to plan for 2025 updates. If you reached the maximum CPP and EI contributions in 2024, remember that these deductions will restart in the first pay period of 2025:

- CPP: \$71,300 max earnings, \$4,034.10 contribution
- CPP2: \$81,200 max earnings, \$396.00 contribution
- EI: \$65,700 max earnings, \$1,077.48 contribution

Deductions stop automatically once limits are met. Reviewing your payroll details now can help ensure a smooth start to the new year.



RRSP Contributions (Non-Union Workforce):

Did you know you can make additional RRSP contributions through the Manulife retirement page anytime? These contributions can help you maximize your 2024 tax savings. Don't forget—the deadline for 2024 contributions is the end of February.

Naming Your Beneficiaries:

It's an often overlooked but vital step in managing your benefits. Check out the attached instructions to ensure your beneficiary details are current.

IT Insights

New Tools and Systems

Exciting changes are underway to improve our technology experience. We are transitioning from Citrix to a new Parallels environment, simplifying remote access for all applications. Additionally, we've enhanced data integration between key systems, allowing automatic syncing with on-premise platforms. This saves hours of manual work and significantly reduces errors. We've also deployed a new email agent that automates tasks such as updating inventory pricing, generating client invoice reports, sending out alerts, and streamlining processes that previously required manual intervention.

Troubleshooting for PTW Email Accounts

A few simple steps can help resolve common IT issues more efficiently for those with PTW email accounts. Restarting your computer regularly eliminates most day-to-day problems, and closing unnecessary windows, browsers, and applications frees up memory, ensuring smoother performance. If you need to reset your password, several convenient options are available, including the [PTW Password Reset](#), the IT page on Pathway, or through [Microsoft Office](#) by selecting "forgot password" and following the prompts.



Upcoming Upgrades and Innovations

Looking ahead, we're implementing a new instance of the Electronic Work Ticket System (EWT) to support the Pacific Northwest, ensuring robust functionality for this group. To maintain top-tier security, we'll upgrade PTW's main firewalls to Next Generation Firewalls as they approach their end-of-support in September 2025. Similarly, with Windows 10 nearing its end-of-support in 2025, we are continuing to transition PTW computers to Windows 11. Finally, ongoing efforts to add new customers to billing portals are set to improve invoice automation and enhance efficiency across the board.



Cybersecurity Awareness

As we move into the new year, it's important to stay vigilant against scams. Gift card scams remain common, with fraudsters impersonating trusted contacts. Always verify such requests and avoid unknown emails or texts. Be cautious of urgency scams demanding gift cards or QR code payments—genuine authorities will never ask for this. AI-driven voice-mimicking scams are also on the rise, so double-check any suspicious messages. Lastly, ensure websites are legitimate before entering payment information to avoid phishing attacks. Stay alert to protect your personal and financial information.

Q4 IT Success Story

Our IT team recently revamped the invoice submission process for Cenovus, streamlining field ticket submissions, client approvals, and invoice conversions. While the system took months of effort across multiple teams to develop, it is expected to save significant time and effort in the future once fully optimized. This is a great example of how collaboration and innovation can enhance productivity.


Delivering Excellence: E-House Project
